



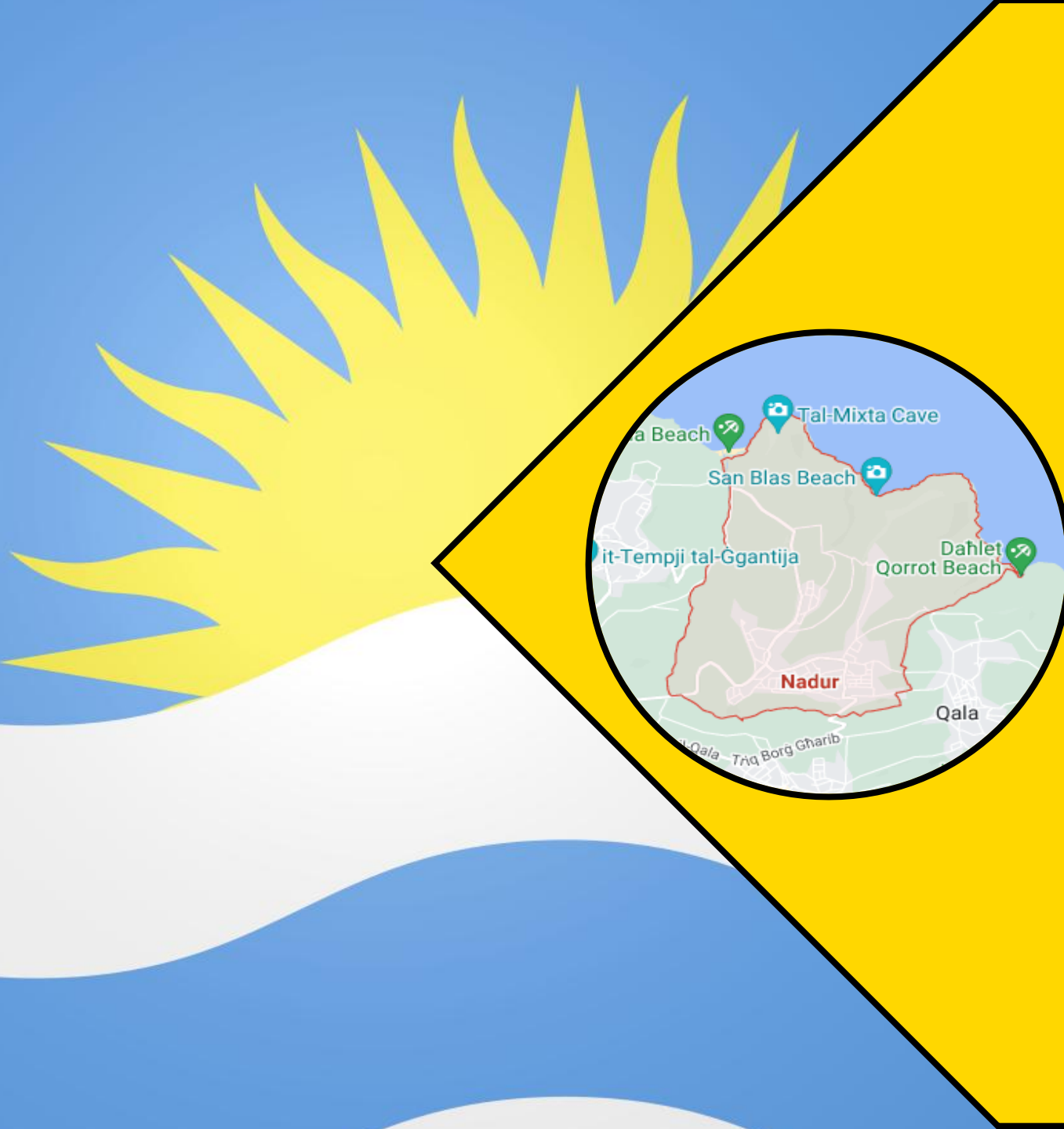
# NADUR

**Gozo ~ Malta**



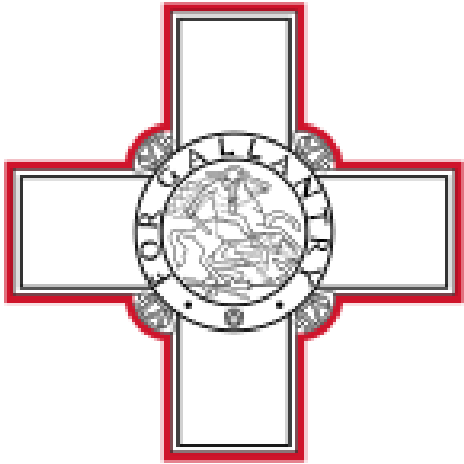
**Malta is located 259.2 km south of Sicily and is made up of 3 islands : Malta, Gozo and Comino**





- Our village **Nadur** is situated on a hill in the southeastern part of Gozo, the small sister island of Malta.
- Nadur is one of the largest villages in Gozo, with a population of about 5000.
- The word 'Nadur' is derived from the Arabic word 'nadara', which means 'lookout'.
- Nadur is called the village of the rising sun, and its coat of arms shows the sun coming up from blue seas.

# LANGUAGE



In Malta we Speak both **Maltese** and **English**, this means we are bilingual.

Maltese is :

- The only Semitic language written in the Latin alphabet.
- Its vocabulary is a mix of Arabic, Italian, and English.
- It's a UNESCO-recognized intangible cultural heritage.
